



Directions:

- 1.) Scale shoe template to size and print out at proper scale. Your foot should fit well within the holes to be drilled out of the bottom piece.
- 2.) Trace or affix to carpet sample and proceed to cut out each shape.
- 3.) You may choose to sand down edges a bit and also trim stray carpet fibers from edges of pieces before assembly.
- 4.) Drill out all of the holes as per the template. It is important that the number of holes match as well as the distance between the holes matching as close as possible.
- 5.) After drilling out all of the holes, proceed to stitch the pieces together. (I chose to double up the twine when stitching the pieces together for a more full looking stitch.)
6. Repeat & Enjoy!

Tools you will need.

- Carpet Tile (Rubber Backed)
- Industrial Scissors or Utility Knife
- Twine
- Large Needle
- Drill or Dremel & Small Drill Bit
- Sandpaper - Optional
